Hill Cul-De-Sac

The Township withheld a payment in the amount of \$12,893.40 due to concerns regarding the workmanship. The townships options were reviewed with respect to insuring the end product is in accordance with the specifications, the decision that the best option is to release payment for the wearing course, and complete an inspection of the paving in April/May 2015. A Motion was made to pay the contractor \$12,893.40 by Carr second by Sterling.

A detail was forwarded to modify the pipe at the dry hydrant. It should be installed to reduce the probability of the inlet freezing.
