ENGINEERS REPORT

Hill Cul-De-sac -- Work is complete; recommendations were to hold 1% until spring, a discussion was held on the repaving and seams. A Motion was made to pay \$56,693.21 holding the remaining balance until spring 2015. Mr. Bosack will review the contract.

Hydraulic Model A Memo was received on the findings for the hydraulic model which includes the base conditions and four alternates.
