Hill Cul-de-sac >>The Contractor reseeded the cul-de-sac area and sealed a minor edge crack.

BBZ Property-Concept plan>> Surveying is started to establish existing property pins. Work will continue sporadically over the next few months. Upon completion of the property surveys, the results will be presented and discussions will be held to move forward with the annexations and new lot plans.

CDBG Demolition Grant>> the demolition grant application for the property at 1468 Sunbury Road has been completed. A resolution was passed approving the submission of the demolition request to the County. The estimated grant amount is \$25,000.00. Township will be responsible for 25% of the demolition costs. Motion by Carr Second b Zula all in favor.

Greenway, Trail and Recreation Program (GTRP) >> The Commonwealth Financing Authority has opened their 2015 GTRP Program, Projects require a 15% local cash match of the total project cost A Motion was made to pass a resolution to apply for the GTRP Grant by Sterling second by Carr ZULA not in favor of the project.
