The regular monthly meeting of the Foster Township Supervisors was held at Municipal Building.

Copies of the previous meeting minutes were given to the Supervisors.

Addition to the minutes requested by Gene Maley, -Question from last month's meeting from Joseph Zula if there was plans to lower real estate mileage for Foster Township. Chairman Sterling explained lowering the mileage would pose an unfair advantage to the big corporations. Supervisors advised previously not to lower the mileage but lower yearly sewer rate by giving more free months, this would only help the residents and not the big corporation.

Other changes quote given in the minutes for Wentz Excavating included the removal of two trees by the township building. The bid for the cul-de-sac should be \$5,940.00.

Motion to accept the minutes with these additions by Carr second by Sterling.

A discussion was held on the recent vacancy on the board with the passing of Supervisor Mr. Richard Zula . Chairman Sterling said numerous people are interested in the position a special meeting will be published in the paper to appoint a new Supervisor.

#### ENGINEER'S Report

2016 Road Program>>>> SEAL COAT>> the contractor will be contacted to set up the preconstruction meeting and a tentative start date.

COMMUNITY SQUARE >>>the necessary survey work to identify the existing pipe location and capacity. Two locations which include the installation of a new pipe or utilization of the existing pipe increasing the inlet capacity within the system. Bids will be received at the July meeting.

DCNR PLANNING GRANT>>>> the project kickoff was held May 26, 2016, a meeting will be set to finalize the planning committee and submit the list to DCNR. Chairman Sterling request interested parties to submit their names to the Board.

PLESAANT ROAD CULVERT>>>> A field view was completed on May 12, 2016 and it was evaluated for drainage, since the drainage is less than 100 acres, no permits from PADEP are required. Construction plans and easement exhibits are being prepared.

2016 CFA PLAYGROUND GRANT>>>>the grant is open with a deadline of June 30, 2016. If interested a resolution needs to be passed tonight.
