ENGINEERS REPORT

2016 Road Program>>>>a Notice of Award on April 7, 2016 was issued to Hammaker East LTD in the amount of \$12,750.00 for the double seal coat of Buckhorn Road .A notice to proceed will be issued on May 5, 2016. A preconstruction meeting will then be set with a tentative start date.

Community Square>>> the Necessary survey work to identify the existing pipe location and capacity was completed. Two locations were reviewed, which include the installation of a new pipe or utilization of the existing pipe and increasing the inlet capacity within the system. Bids are expected to be received for the June meeting.

DCNR Planning Grant>>>>. A kick off meeting will be set up at a later date with DCNR Project Coordinator. DCNR recommends the township begin formulating a study committee list. They suggests seeking out residents who believe in the project and are willing to make time for it.

PLEASANT Road Culvert/Pipe >>>>Data will be obtained from PENNDOT, PADEP, Highridge, and field visits will be conducted to identify the actual drainage area. Once this information is obtained the permit if any will be identified from PADEP. Construction easements from the adjacent land owners will be necessary to complete the work.
