PUBLIC COMMENT

Gene Maley questions where clean fill be brought in for the Master-site Plan area from. Dan Cook says Wegman's will be doing an expansion and the clean fill will come from that project.

Joe Zula asks about dust control if fill will be brought in by his property. Mr. Sterling states proper dust control will be in place.

Gene Maley asks on cost to date on Master-site Plan and what projected expenses are in the plan.

David Zula asks if a question can be put on the ballot in November to see if township residents are in favor of this plan.

Total cost estimate for the Master-site plan will be done by Alfred Baensch.

ENGINEER REPORT

2017 Boiler Replacement Project>>>>>the notice to proceed for the Boiler Replacement project was issued to Sommers INC.

2017 HVAC Replacement Project>>>> the existing HVAC system was evaluated. Contractor contacted were Sommers, Losch and Jack Rich. Only two quotes were received to date----- Sommers \$6400.00, Jack Rich. Inc. \$9876.00. A Motion was made by Carr second by Sterling to award the project to Sommers. Inc. for \$6400.00.

2017 Schuylkill County Dirt, Gravel Roadway Grant>>>>>Schuylkill County Conversation District met with John Carr and the engineers to identify any roads in the township that would be eligible for funding through the grant. Based on the site visit there were no roadways identified for rehabilitation through this grant program.

2017 Road Program>>>>>Shop drawing were received and approved for drawing submittals for the inlets and piping. The contractor was contacted and indicated that the inlets were ordered. Once the inlets are received the contractor intends on installing the Pipe and inlets and reconstructing the roadway.

Mr. And Mrs. Greg Sterling were contacted regarding the replacement of the existing clogged storm water pipe. The necessary easement was forwarded to Mr. Brennan.
