ENGINEERS REPORT

2017 ROAD PROGRAM

The contractor has completed the necessary tests pits on site and has determined that the existing pipe is clogged. It is recommended that the Township replace the pipe. A formal meeting is requested with the township, the Solicitor, the homeowner to identify the final location and any easements.

BBZ SUDDIVISION PLAN

The surveyors have completed the identification of the remainder of the property on the southern portion of the site and completed the topographic survey. The drafting of the overall plan that will be used for the subdivision plan is started. A workshop will be held with the supervisors to review the findings of the neighbors meeting and provide recommendation to move forward with the annexations. The meeting will be scheduled after the next Master Site Plan committee meeting. A local business will be expanding and is looking for a disposal site. If the Township When the township intends to develop the site into a park, a second NPDES permit would be needed to address storm water management. is interested in obtaining this material for both the development of the road frontage lot and additional material for the large sports field with a disturbance greater than one acre, then A NPDES permit needs to be completed.

DCNR Master Site Plan

The Wetland delineation. Has been completed on both the BBZ property and two similar smaller parcels by Clauser Environmental.

2017 CDBG GRANT

The Schuylkill County commissioners have opened the 2017 CDBG grant, which is due October 5, 2017. The county will cover the costs of the engineering and construction should the grant be awarded to the township. Income surveys would need to be completed. . A resolution needs to be passed by the September meeting.
