A copy of the previous meeting minutes were given to the Supervisors, there were no corrections the minutes stand approved.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Gene Maley question when a final plan meeting will be held for Master-site Plan.

Mr. Maley questions landfill agreement on host fees. Chairman Sterling explains the agreement states we will continue to get the host fee from CES although they have expanded into another township. When Contacted Mr. DE Naples stated the landfill has about 30 more years of operation.

Joe Zula asks the board to consider finishing the lighting project, and requests minutes from the Master-site plan meetings.

ENGINEER REPORT

2017 BOILER REPLACEMENT PROJECT >>>>The Boiler has been inspected by the Dept. of Labor and Industry, DLI recommends the addition of one sensor, which the contractor has ordered and will be installed when the item is delivered.

2017 HVAC REPLACEMENT PROJECT>>>>>The HVAC Unit has been installed and placed into operation.

DRIVEWAY PERMIT QUESTION>>>>Question was received from a resident regarding the Township Highway Occupancy > A copy of the Foster Township Driveway Ordinance (2-2006), Permit Application and Construction standards have been sent to the resident.

READING ANTHRACITE DEMOLITION>>>>>An estimate of cost for the demolition of four residential structures located on Reading Anthracite Property, including asbestos investigation engineering bidding, construction administration and Foster Township UCC permit fee. The estimate of the four structures is \$75,000.00 based on public bidding bid all at one time similar to the County Demolition Program.

2017 ROAD PROGRAM>>>>>M&J Excavation has completed punchlist items and should be submitting the final application for payment for next month's meeting.

The Township labor force has been working on topsoil restoration and seeding. The necessary inlet has been ordered and will be installed once manufactured. Quotes for the concrete restoration were as follows:
