A special meeting was held to adopt the proposed budget for 2018:

1. Real Estate Taxes remain the same at 8.2 Mills.
2. Sewer remains the same \$30.00 for the months of July-December with a three dollar late fee if NOT paid by the 30th of each month. All residents are subject to the fee.
3. Budgeted \$.50 per hour for employees, Garbage collection will remain the same at \$68.00 per week for each employee.
4. Budgeted \$1.00 per hour raise for police patrolman, \$1.00 per hour per Police Chief.
5. Public works capital purchases \$59,000 for skid Loader.
6. Acquisition of land \$1000,000.00
7. Supervisors surplus \$26,227.00
8. Municipal Authority \$26,227.00
9. Liquid Fules budget Surplus \$13,246.00
10. Sewer budget loss of \$98,993.00

Motion to adopt the proposed 2018 Budget by Rowlands second by Carr all in favor.

A meeting followed for general Purposed which was advertised in the Pottsville Republican.

A Proclamation was read by Sterling designating the month of April as "Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month". Motion to sign the proclamation with a motion by Rowlands second by Carr all in favor.

A letter was read from the PA Gaming Control Board on: Municipal Option to Prohibit Sitting of Category 4 Casino. Supervisors agree not to pass a resolution to opt out, allowing Category 4 casinos to locate within 25 linear miles of an existing Category 1, 2, or 3 casino facility. Motion by Rowlands second, by Carr all in favor.

Delinquent Sewer bills were read with a motion to turn the accounts over to the Solicitor for collection.
