ENGINEER REPORT

Schuylkill County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update>>>>Schuylkill County EMA Officials are currently meeting individually with Municipalities. There is no current proposed date for a meeting, but is anticipated for the next several weeks.

PENNDOT Green Light GO>>. >>>> PENNDOT does not have an original signed copy of the Grant Agreement or Resolution. Township and SEDCO records indicate the paperwork was forwarded to PENNDOT on or around Aug 11, 2017. PENNDOT has requested that the township approve a new resolution and re-execute the agreement and return to their office no later than February 12, 2018.

Schuylkill County Demolition Fund>>> Schuylkill County has opened their 2018 Demolition fund. If the Township would be interested to applying, the structure must pose a threat to the public health, safety and welfare and the structure must either be condemned via a court-ordered demolition or owned by the Municipality.

DCNR Master Site Plan>>>>>The draft has been submitted to DCNR for their preliminary review, once DCNR has reviewed and commented on the plan , a final plan presentation meeting will be scheduled. The report will be on display for public review and written comment.
